


Overview

About the Company

Business Challenge

The challenge was to enhance efficiency, communications, innovation and cost containment initiatives by leveraging technology to effectively position the company for new opportunities.

This solution would require reliable connectivity from various warehouses and distribution outlets across Nigeria to a centralized ERP platform responsible for automating and supporting business processes from the supply chain to finance and customer service management.

Solution

MainOne put together a robust disaster recovery operation with the deployment of an active - active collocation service between the Company head office and MDXi - the Tier III Certified Data Center. Network connectivity to remote sites was delivered via a Layer 3 IP/MPLS virtual private network while direct connectivity to the colocated racks from the head office was established using a Layer 2 virtual private network on diverse optical fiber routes.

As a standard in the data center, five levels of security were put in place prior to rack access and all physical activity on the customer racks were supervised and monitored from a 24x7x365 Global Network Operations Center.

Results

By outsourcing their data center services, the company saved approximately 50% of its budget for IT security and Data Storage while freeing up time for internal resources to effectively focus on its core business and increase operational efficiency.

Apart from enjoying a minimum of 99.982% availability, the business now leverages on an always available ERP for real time business insight, centralized records and most importantly the ability to dynamically scale operations to integrate new systems, processes and products without any downtime.
